China Black Tea

Pu-erh

All Pu-erh teas have a common 'elemental', earthy flavor. They have been praised in china since the Tang Dynasty for their medicinal properties. Its deep red amber color and rich underlying hardness is appealing to many coffee drinkers, yet it is low in caffeine.
